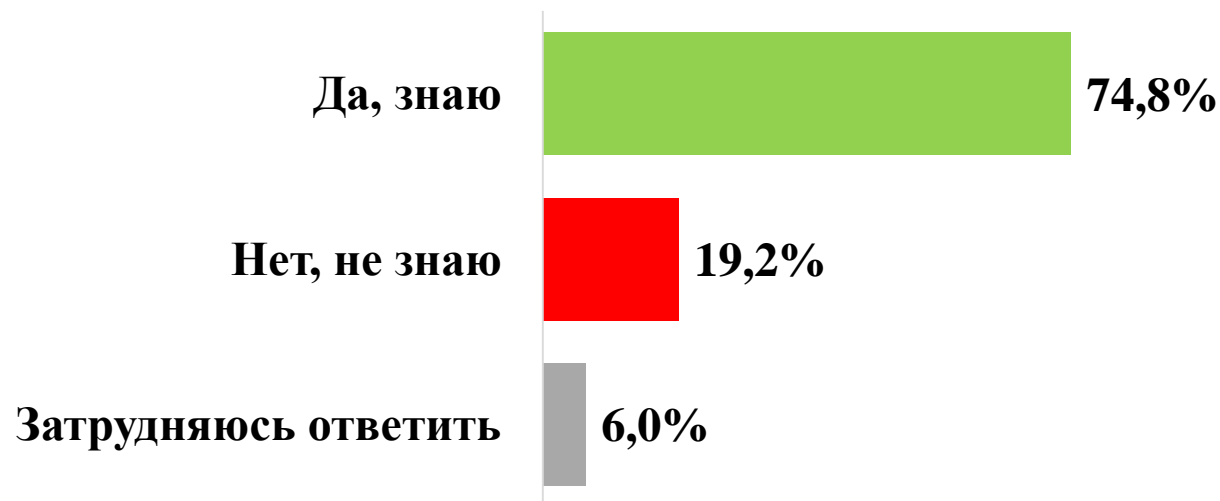

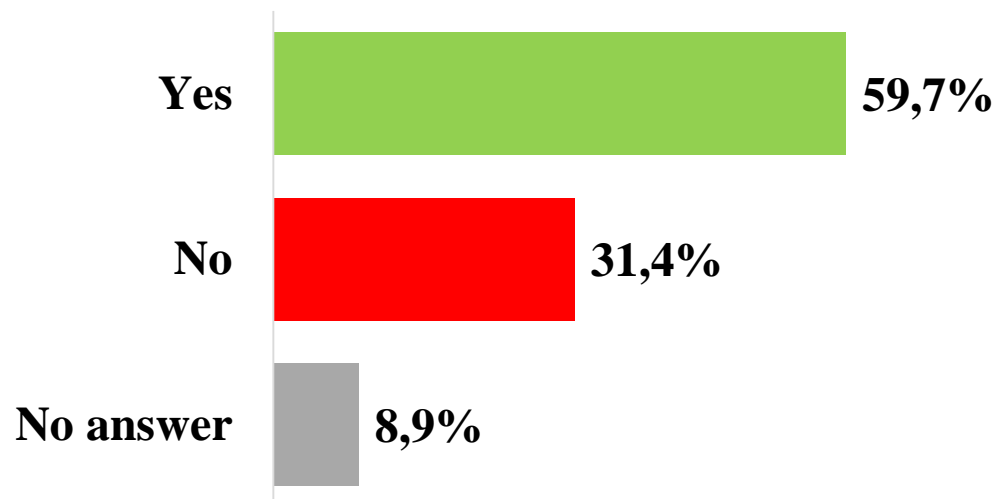

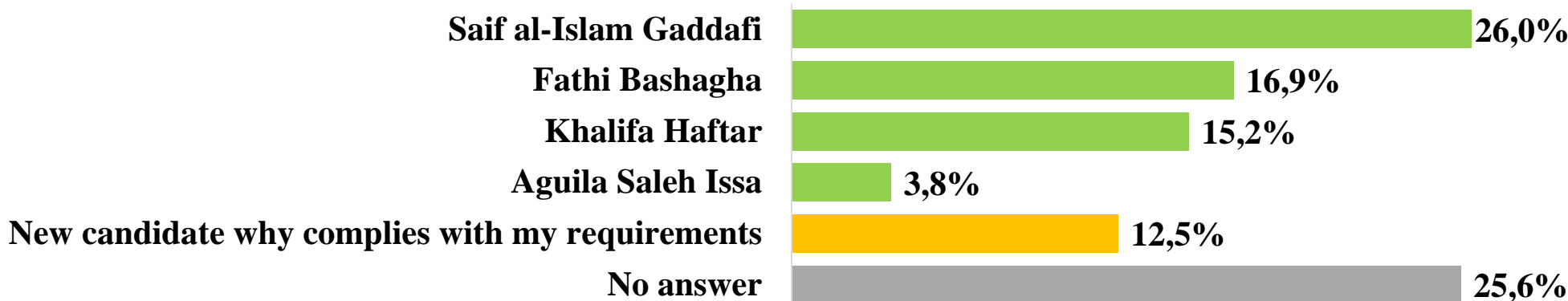

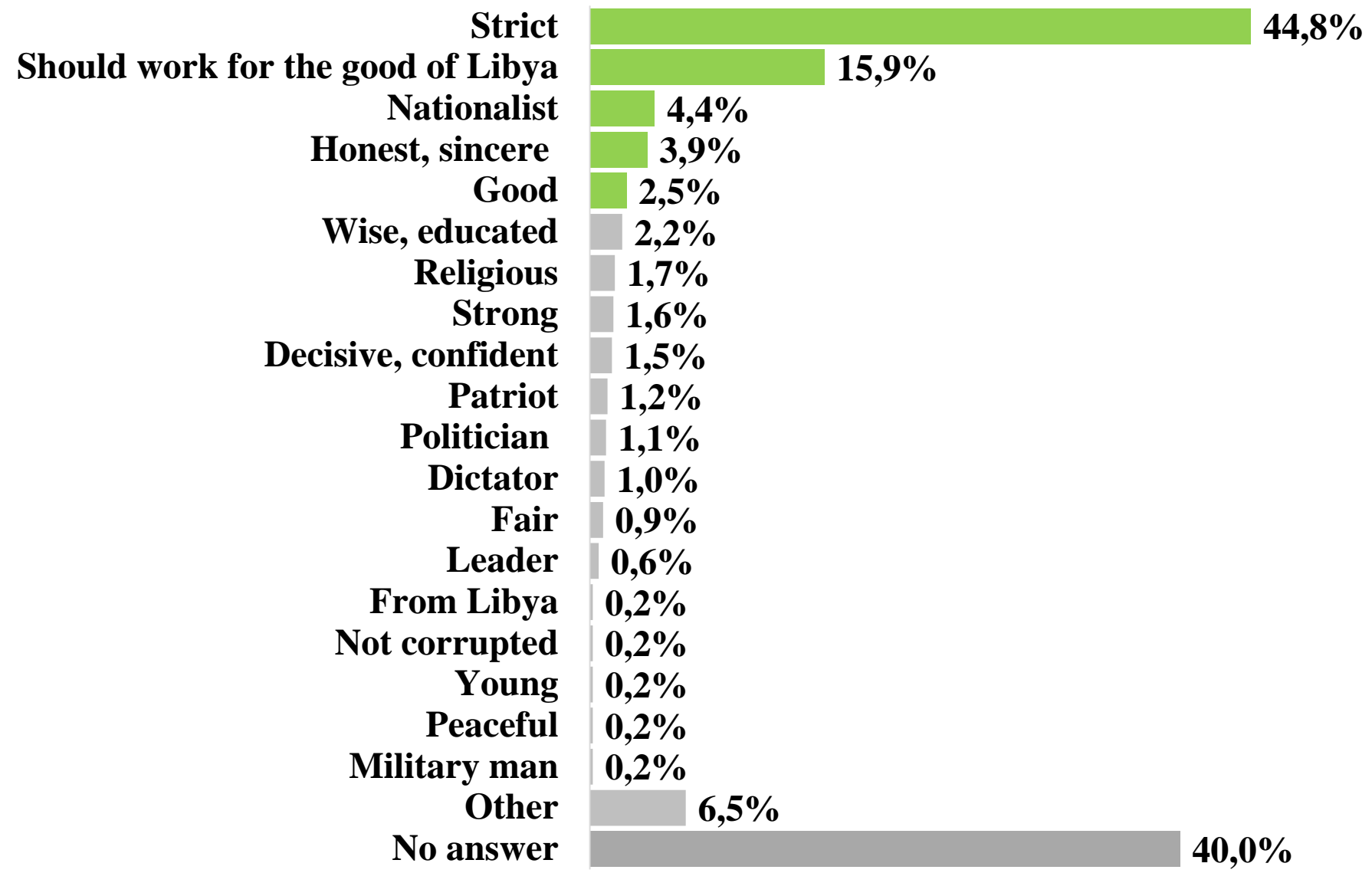

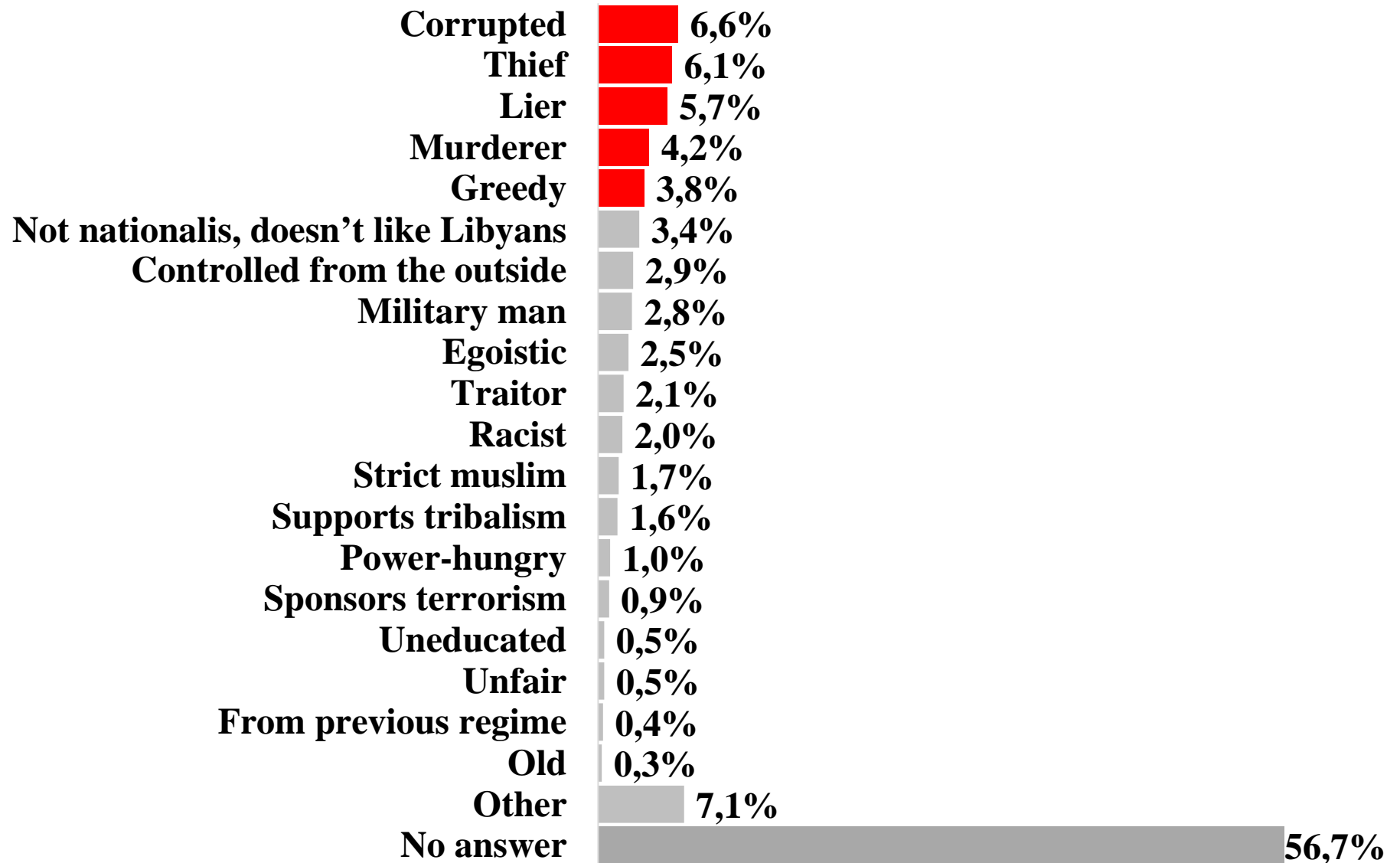




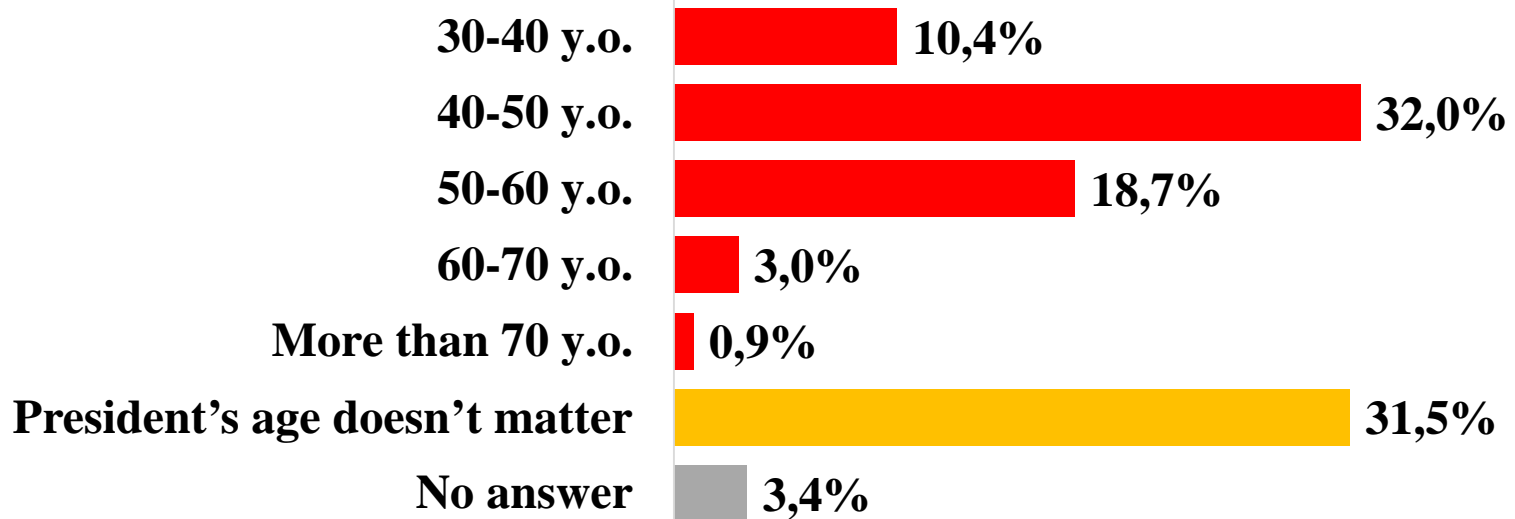
If a new candidate for presidency is concerned, what positive features should he have?



What are the most negative features that would stop your from voting for presidential candidate on the upcoming elections?



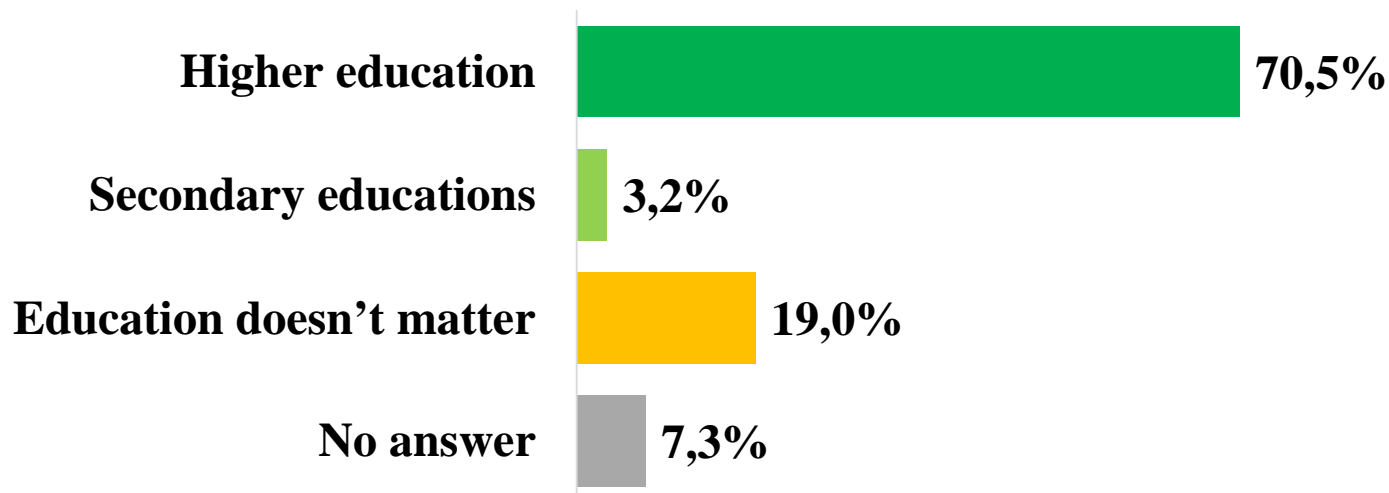

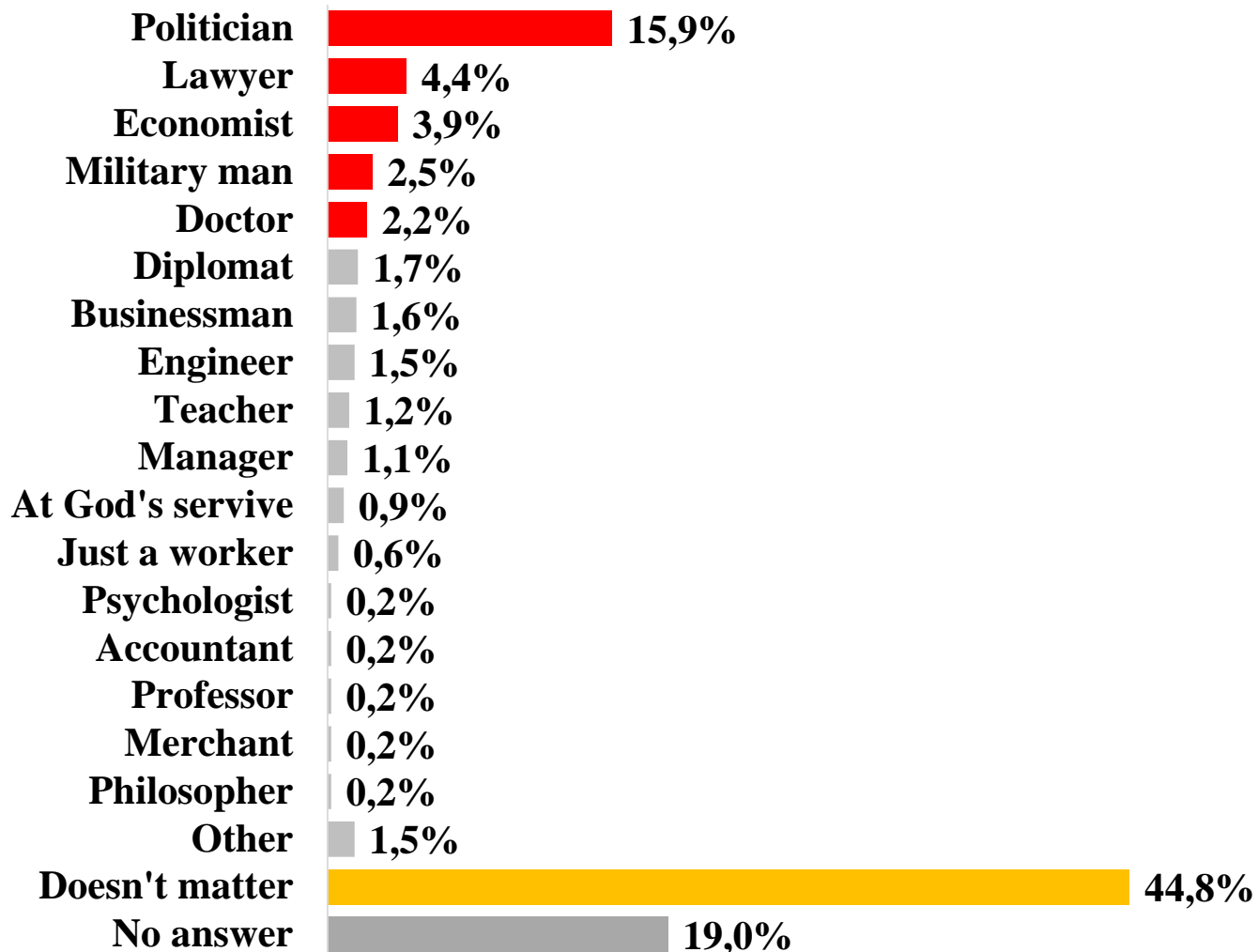

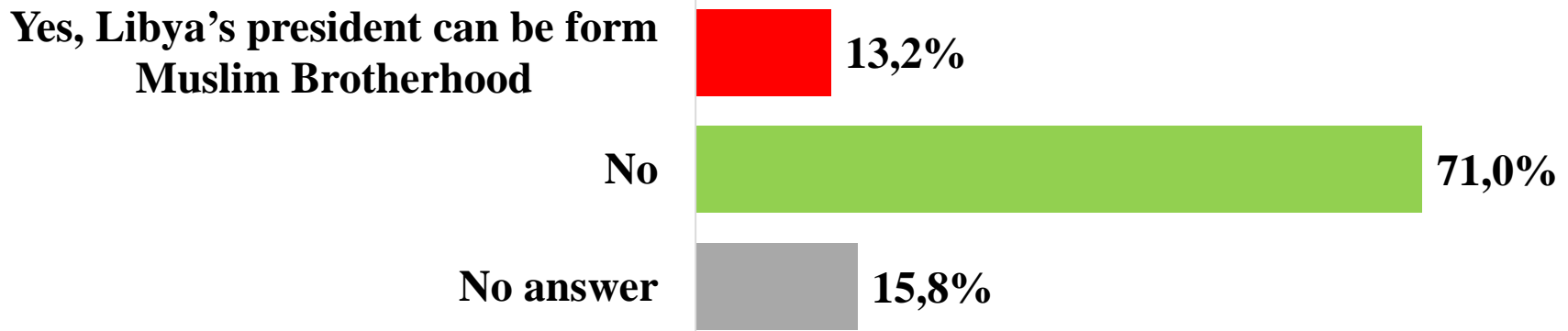

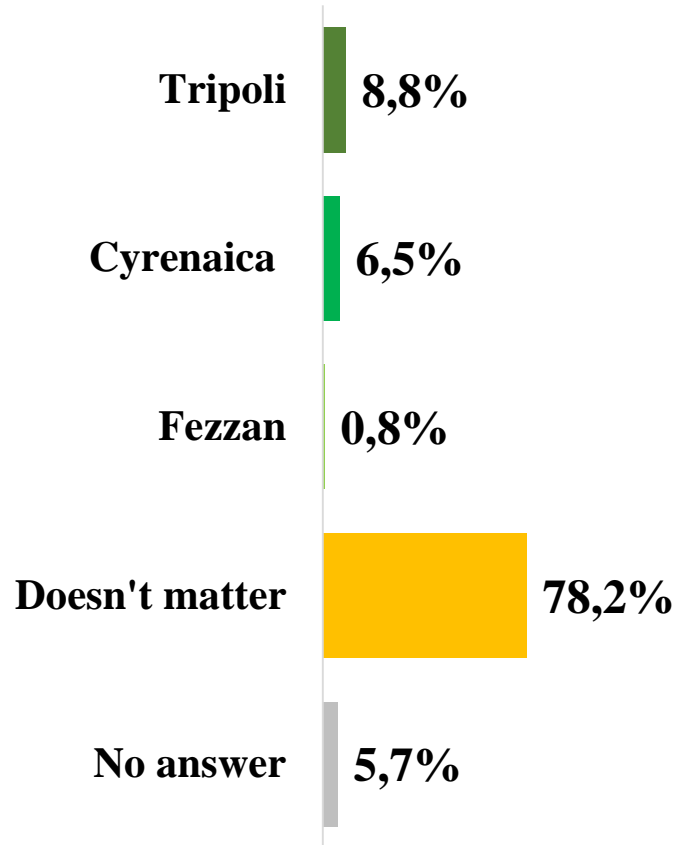

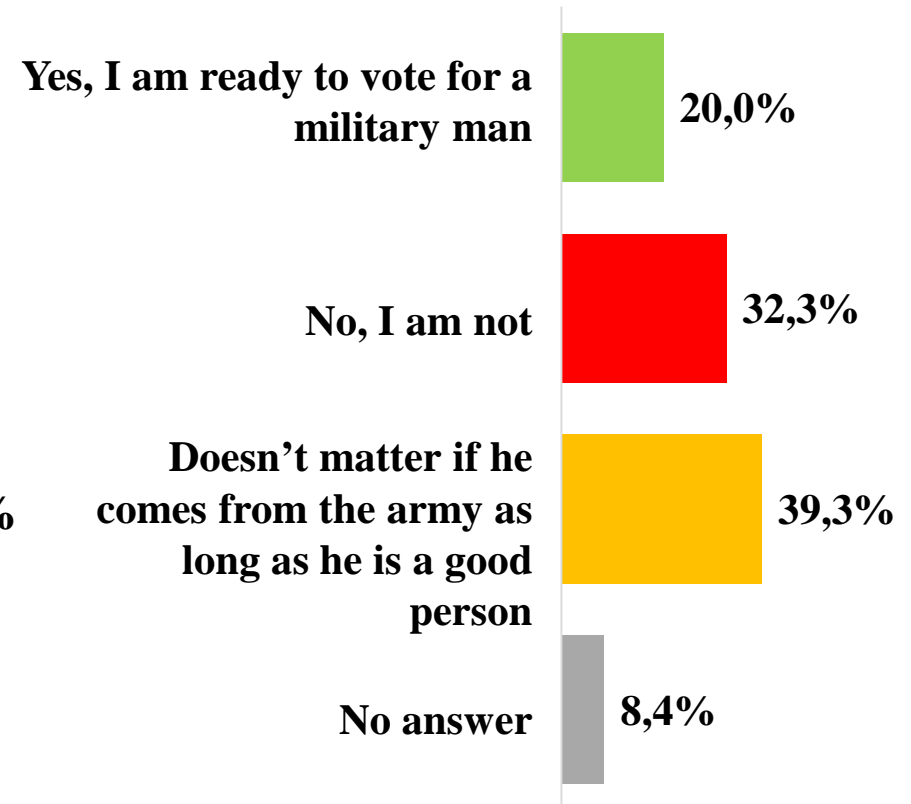

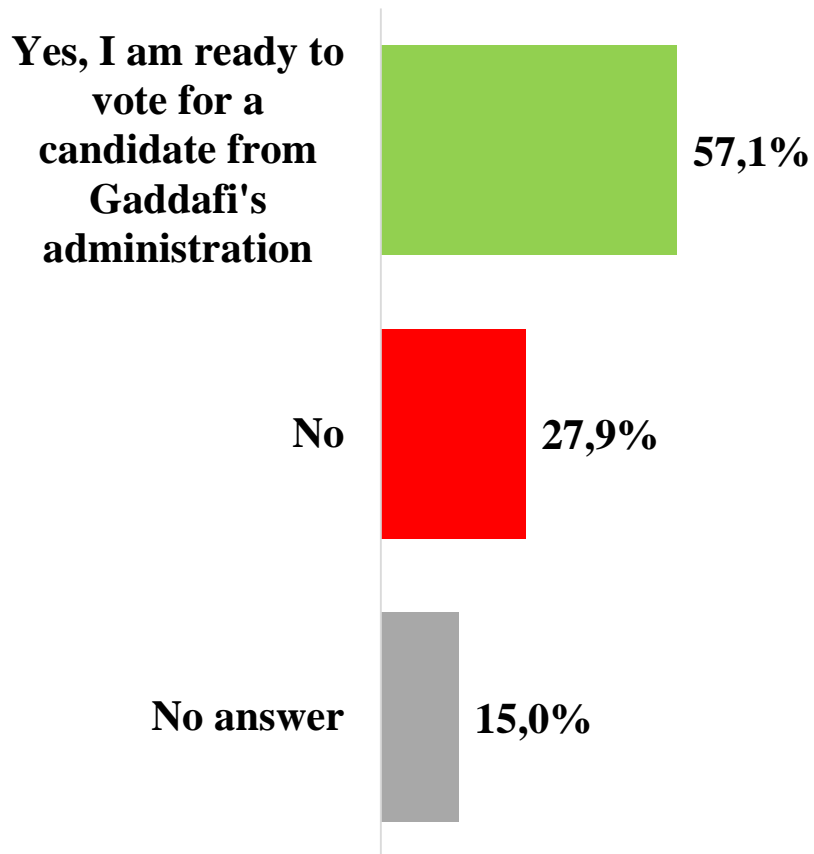
From which historical area of Libya should the president come from?
